Confirmation of the minutes of the last meeting of EC: At the outset, the President, Indian Society of Agronomy extended a warm welcome to all the Executive Council Members of ISA and the following agenda items were discussed after confirming the minutes of the last EC meeting.

# 1. To review the preparedness for the successful organization of Fourth IAC 2016:

#### A. Publication

### **Publication of Text Book**

- i. Modern concepts in agronomy (In press)
- ii. Climate resilient agronomy (In press)
- iii. Weed management (in process)

It was informed by the Secretary that two books are in the press and will be published before the second week of November, 2016. However, third book i.e. 'Weed management' is also in process and Dr A.R. Sharma, Coordinator of this book has assured to get it printed by 18 November, 2016. The President, ISA asked to get published all the planned text book well in time for their release during the Congress. Further, he advised to take in writing from the press for their timely publication to avoid any last minutes' hassle.

## **Extended summary**

So far we have received 1100 extended summaries and all have been reviewed by the publication committee. These will be passed on to press for final printing on or before 25<sup>th</sup> October, 2016. Secretary also informed that we will not consider any contributed extended summaries for publication after 25<sup>th</sup> October 2016. EC agreed for the same.

## Special issue of IJA on Pulses

The Secretary informed the house that the Special Issue of IJA on Pulses is in the press. Corrected proofs by both editors and authors have been submitted to the press

for incorporation of the modification/ corrections. We expect to receive the copies by first week of November 2016.

#### Souvenir

The Secretary apprised the EC members that we have finalized 11 articles for the Souvenir and these are in the proof reading stage. Further, it was also informed by the Secretary that the secretariat office has received six messages for the Souvenir from the VVIP's including Hon'able Prime Minister of India. The President asked the Secretary to print Souvenir at least 10 days before the Congress scheduled date.

### 2. Position of funds for the Fourth IAC 2016:

The President raised the major concerned about the fund-raising activities and advised the Convener and Co-convener of the committee to put their best efforts with full zeal and commitment to generate more funds for the smooth organization of the Fourth International Agronomy Congress. President, ISA further emphasized that our target should be to raise funds of more than one crore rupees to meet out the actual Congress expenses. The Convener and Co-convener of the Fund-raising committee assured the house to put their best efforts to realize desired amount of funds.
